

And they the Said Rowland Beavins Senio^r & Junio^r with y^e sd Robert Smith doe Report & Say to the Wor^{ll}. Court, that in obedience to the foresd Order of Court, they have inspected into the sd King Daniels Lands, & have rightly found out his lines and bounds, & doe find that he the sd John Parker hath built nigh half a mile within the sd Kings Land & bounds – Whereupon this Court having well Considered y^e premises Doe Order that he the sd John Parker from hence forward wholy desist from any further proceeding or building upon the foresd King Daniels Land. the matter thereon Consisting of the Peace & Welfare of this Province. &ca. old page 73

To the worshipful 'Justices' of Somerset County Court the petition of Daniel King of King Daniel Pet.ⁿ the Pocomoke Indian Town That your petitioner and the Indians under him have a parcel of Land in the County aforesaid Commonly known by the Name of Pocomoke Indian Town the boundarys whereof are like to be lost and the wittnesses to prove them Ancient and Infirm, Your petitioner therefore humbly prays your worships will Issue a Commission to such persons as you shall think proper to Examine witnesses to perpetuate the boundarys thereof according to the form of the act of assembly in that Case made & Daniel. The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had &.° Wherefore it is Considered by the Justices here that a Commission Issue to the aforesaid Daniel King of Pocomoke Indian Town as by the petition aforesaid is praid and that Levin Gale, John Scott, Francis Allen and W.^m Handy of Somerset County Gentlemen be Commissioners and Execute the Same Commission according to Law & Ordered by the Court that John Jones William Stoughton and John Handy of Somerset County Gent meet at a Certain place and time by them to be appointed for the regulating of the standard of the County aforesaid County.
